Ski amadé = Investment

The Ski amadé regions are constantly investing in lifts, service quality and ensuring that there is always plenty of snow.

Investment 2020/21	€ 74 Mio.
Investment 2021/22	€ 66 Mio.
Investment 2022/23	€ 44 Mio.

This includes future investments in new cable cars, such as the new construction of the 10-person gondola lift at Galsterberg/Schladming-Dachstein or the combined lift at Rittisberg/Schladming-Dachstein, among others. There is also a new online early booking system for all five regions in Ski amadé, which ensures attractive ticket prices.

Ski amadé = Snow guarantee

- **90 % of the slope areas**, i.e. approx. 684 km of slopes, in Ski amadé can be **covered with artificial snow**.
- Over **4,300 snow canons** produce around 15 million m³ of machine-made snow
- Snow production only from pure water and air in accordance with the Austrian environmental purity law
- Costs for one m³ of machine-made snow (average of the last 5 years): **approx. €3,55**
- Share of **snowmaking costs** in total costs (average of the last 5 years): **approx. 25%**
- Average **revenue** per ski day: approx. **€ 37,50**
- 300 employees and 170 piste bashers ensure that the slopes are perfect!

Ski amadé Winter 2021/22:

Last winter was already the second with uncertainties and many question marks. Despite the difficult situation, Ski amadé can look back on a satisfactory season and is starting the 2022/2023 winter season not only optimistically, but also with top preparations. Guests from almost all countries were able to travel to Austria (partly under certain conditions) and spend a normal skiing holiday in Ski amadé as far as possible. It has been confirmed once again that skiing as an outdoor sport is not only really healthy but can also take place without restrictions as far as it was possible.

- 6.28 million overnight stays (2019/20: 6.68 million | 2020/21: 0.3 million)
- 1.22 million guest arrivals (2019/20: 1.36 million | 2020/21: 0.03 million)
- Around 6.5 million first-time admissions (2019/20: 7.0 million | 2020/21: 1.5 million)
- Around 2.5 million ski tickets sold (2019/20: 2.8 million | 2020/21: 0.7 million)
- Around 70.5 million lift rides (transports) (2019/20: 72 million | 2020/21: 15.9 million)
